

Rules for the Miss Tembisa pageant:

- 1. Eligibility: Contestants must be female residents of Tembisa, South Africa, and must meet the age requirements specified by the pageant organisers.
- 2. Conduct: Contestants are expected to conduct themselves in a respectful and professional manner at all times, both during the pageant events and in their public and social media presence. Any behavior deemed inappropriate, including but not limited to bullying, harassment, or discriminatory speech, may result in penalties or disqualification.
- 3. Attendance and punctuality: Contestants are required to attend all scheduled rehearsals, events, and appearances as directed by the pageant organisers. Punctuality is crucial, and repeated tardiness may result in point deductions or other penalties.
- 4. Attire: Contestants are expected to adhere to the specified dress code for each event and to present themselves in a tasteful and appropriate manner at all times.
- 5. Compliance with instructions: Contestants are required to follow the instructions and guidance of the pageant organisers and staff. Failure to comply with directives related to rehearsals, appearances, or other aspects of the competition may result in penalties.
- 6. Professionalism: Contestants should maintain a professional and positive attitude throughout the competition. Any behavior that reflects poorly on the pageant or its sponsors may result in penalties or disqualification.
- 7. Non-Disclosure: Contestants are expected to adhere to any non-disclosure agreements regarding the pageant's proceedings, including but not limited to the scoring process and behind-the-scenes activities.
- 8. Disqualification: The pageant organizers reserve the right to disqualify a contestant for serious or repeated violations of the rules, as well as for any conduct deemed detrimental to the integrity of the competition.
